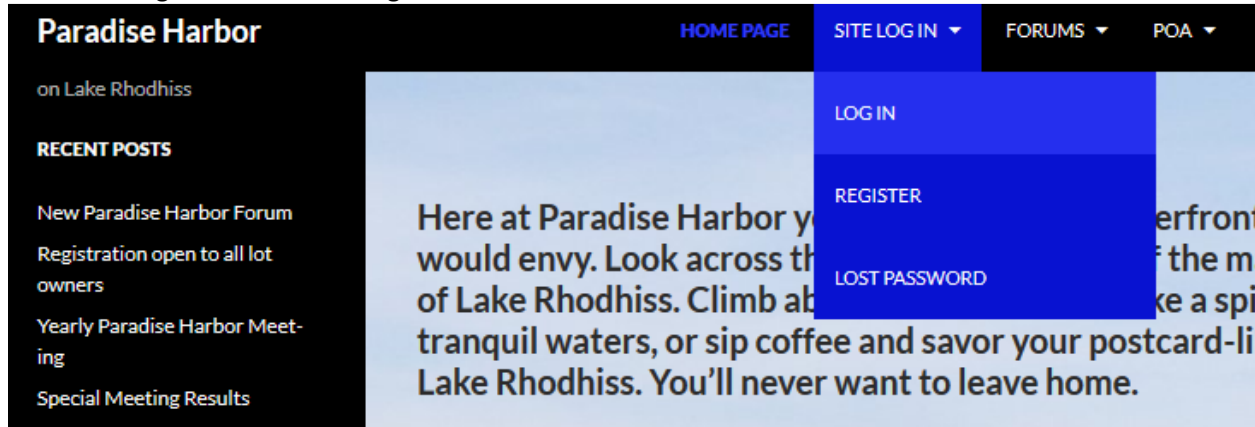


Paradise Harbor Web Register Instructions

Enter: <https://www.paradiseharbornc.com/> in web browser address.


Go to Site Log IN and click on Register



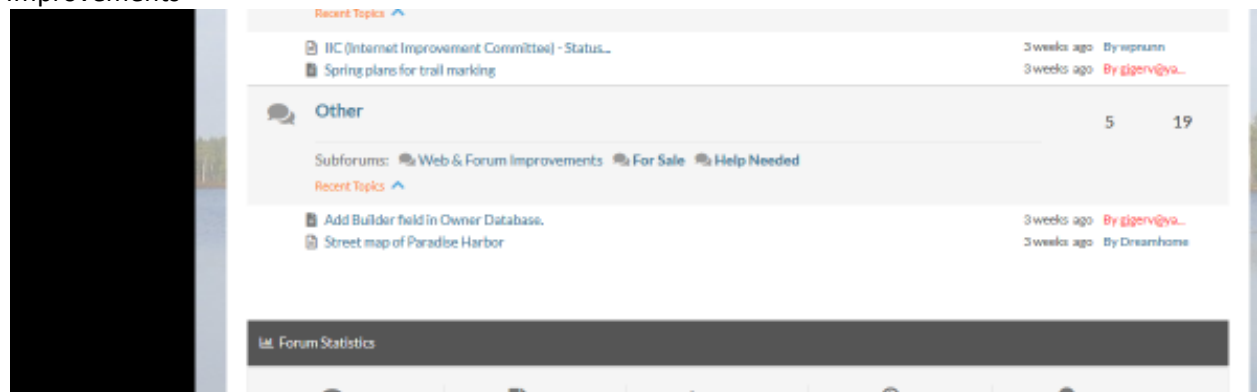
